Genesis- The Madras Medical Mission

The Madras Medical Mission is an organization inspired by the missionary zeal of Bishop Zachariah Mar Dionysius, Metropolitan of the Madras Diocese of the Orthodox Church of India, strengthened by the devotion and commitment of the members of this Community at Chennai (erstwhile Madras city of Tamil Nadu) who promoted the registered society in 1982. It strives to participate in the healing ministry by seeking to foster an environment of caring, compassion and love that enables it to respond to patient needs in enviable ways. MMM has entered into the Silver Jubilee in the year 2007.

The mission's effort to establish an institution to engage in the Ministry of Healing resulted in setting up its first unit relating to cardiac care in June 1987 in the hired premises of another hospital in the Mecca of Health Care in India – Chennai. Within a short period, from this humble abode, The Madras Medical Mission moved in 1995 to its own premises at Mogappair, a residential suburb of Chennai city, an aesthetically designed eight storied building around lush green surroundings.

Under the patronage of Mother Theresa, this monumental edifice was inaugurated in the presence of luminaries. The Madras Medical Mission complex with 250 beds set amidst landscaped gardens that provide a serene and tranquil



environment with modern hi-tech and sophisticated infrastructure, state-of-the-art technology, very high standards of cleanliness and hygiene for quaternary care has won accolades from the international community. The hospital is linked with other centers with their telemedicine network to enable sending and receiving digital images, ensuring connectivity with leading institutions for second opinion/ referral services.

Units of The Madras Medical Mission

The Institute of Cardio-vascular Diseases, the forerunner has carved a niche for itself in the international arena for total cardiac care and for provision of world class treatment under one roof for its hi-tech care at affordable prices, was established in 1987. *The Institute of Reproductive Medicine & Women's Health* established in 1999, is a one stop health care provider for women from birth to end of life, *Institute of Liver and Digestive Diseases* was established in 2001. *The Kidney and Organ Transplantation* unit was established in the year 2006, is conceived and executed by a team of highly reputed, and dedicated medical experts with extensive training and experience from North America and Europe. MMM's exclusive centre of excellence in medical learning – *Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS)*, with its medical college and hospital are functioning from 2001 and the College of Nursing PIMS at Pondicherry is functioning from 2004. *College of Health Sciences*, Chennai was established in the year 2006.

MMM COLLEGE OF NURSING in Chennai under “Madras Medical Mission” was started in August 2008 with a view of training professional nurses who will have the potential to deliver quality nursing care to individual, families and groups across their life span in wide variety of health care settings as well as to assume the role of a teacher, supervisor, manager and researcher in the clinical / public health setting.

The College has been formally sanctioned by Government of Tamilnadu (G.O.293 dated 11.08.2007). The college is affiliated to the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai and has been recognized by the Indian Nursing Council and

by Tamilnadu Nurses and Midwives council. The college is located at Nolambur. The College aims at preparing graduates to assume responsibility as Professional, Competent Nurses and Midwives in providing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services.

AIM - MSc. (Nursing)

The aim of postgraduate program in nursing at MMM College of Nursing is to prepare graduates to function in a leadership position in selected areas of clinical speciality, Nursing education, Nursing Administration and in Nursing Research and carryout independent Research Studies.

OBJECTIVES

On Completion of the two years M.Sc Nursing programme, the Post graduate nurse will be able to:-

1. Utilize/apply the concepts, theories and principles of nursing science
2. Demonstrate advance competence in practice of nursing
3. Practice as a nurse specialist.
4. Demonstrate leadership qualities and function effectively as nurse Educator and manager.
5. Demonstrate skill in conducting nursing research, interpreting and utilizing the findings from health related research.
6. Demonstrate the ability to plan and effect change in nursing practice and in the health care delivery system.
7. Establish collaborative relationship with members of other disciplines
8. Demonstrate interest in continued learning for personal and professional advancement.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

1. The candidate should be registered with State Nursing Council.
2. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of B.Sc. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing



3. The candidate should have undergone B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
4. Minimum one year of work experience in teaching hospital or in a college or in a school of nursing after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
5. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc.Nursing.
6. Candidate shall be medically fit.
7. In case of male candidates they should have passed any other course recommended by the Indian Nursing Council in place of Midwifery.
8. Every candidate before admission to this course shall submit to the Principal, MMM College of Nursing a certificate of Medical Fitness from an authorized Medical Officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the Academic Programme.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:

Candidate before seeking admission at MMM College of Nursing shall obtain an Eligibility Certificate from “The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University”, Guindy, Chennai. by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application form which shall be downloaded from the University website (www.tnmgr.ac.in)

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

English shall be the medium of instruction for all the subjects of study and for examinations of the M.Sc. Degree Nursing course.

MEDICAL FITNESS:

Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit the medical fitness certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course and has not suffered from any major disability or any contagious diseases.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. The application form with the prospectus can be obtained from the Administrative office of the “MMM College of Nursing, No.131, Sakthi Nagar, II Avenue , Nolambur, Mogappair West, Chennai – 600 095”, with the

requisition letter by sending a crossed demand draft of Rs.1000/- drawn in favour of MMM College of Nursing, from any nationalized bank payable at Chennai.

2. Application form should be filled by the candidate in her own hand writing
3. The name of the candidate should be stated in the application and other forms as entered in their Higher Secondary / Pre degree mark sheet.
4. The completed application form should be submitted together with the following: (To be attested by a Gazatted Officer)
 - i) Xerox copy of the transfer certificate issued by the head of the institution where last studied.
 - ii) Xerox copy of the SSLC and +2 / pre degree mark list. If it is in any other language other than English, it has to be translated in English and attested by the Principal of the school. If subjects are written in code, the copy of the page where the expansion of the code is given has to be sent along with the mark list.
 - iii) Xerox copy of B.Sc(N) / PB.B.Sc (N) Degree Certificate.
 - iv) Xerox copy of experience certificate.
 - v) Xerox copy of RN/RM Certificate from place of study (if other states) and from Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council.
 - vi) Xerox copy of Community Certificate.
 - vii) Xerox copy of Migration Certificate.
 - viii) Xerox copy of Eligibility Certificate obtained from “The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University”, Guindy, Chennai.
 - ix) Xerox copy of proof of ID and Address.
 - x) 5 Passport size Photograph.
 - xi) Physical fitness Certificate.
 - xii) Xerox copy of the Conduct Certificate from the head of the Institution last attended.
 - xiii) A self addressed envelope with the stamp of Rs.5/- affixed.

5. The information given in the application form should be factual. False Information or suppression of actual information in the application will result in candidate being disqualified irrespective of stage of the course at which the candidate may be at the time of detection
6. The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR medical University also will verify the eligibility of the candidate.
7. The filled in application form with five recent passport size photographs should reach “The Principal, MMM College of Nursing, No.131, Sakthi Nagar, II nd Avenue, Nolambur, Mogappair West, Chennai – 600095”, Tamil Nadu. (Ph: 044 – 26535001 / 26535003) Belated or incomplete application form without necessary enclosures will be rejected.
8. Quote your application number in all further correspondence.
9. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.

MODE OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

1. The candidate will be notified about the personal interview which includes written and viva.
2. At the time of interview, the candidate should have with her the original certificates as mentioned above.

REGISTRATION

A candidate admitted in the Msc (N) PG Degree course in Nursing has to register his/her name with The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R.Medical university by submitting the prescribed application form along with a prescribed fee.

DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of certified study for the M.Sc. Nursing course shall extend over a period of two academic years.

COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

This course will commence from the 1st May and 1st September of the academic year.

WORKING DAYS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR:

Each academic year shall consist of not less than 270 working days.

ATTENDANCE:

The candidate should have 90% of attendance in theory and practicals separately and should have completed all the requirements prescribed for each programme of study including clinical practice before admission to examinations.

- a) No candidate shall be permitted to any one of the parts of M.Sc. Degree course in Nursing unless he/she has attended the course in the subject for the prescribed period in an affiliated institution recognized by this University and produces the necessary certificate of study, attendance and progress from the Head of the Institution.
- b) A candidate lacking in the prescribed attendance and progress in any one subject in theory and practical in the first appearance shall not be permitted for admission to the entire examinations.
- c) A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of Degree.

RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY:

The regulations for re-admission are as per the University Common Regulation for Re-admission after break of study for all courses will be followed.

CONDONATION OF LACK OF ATTENDANCE:

There shall be no condonation of lack of attendance to Post-graduate course.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum and the syllabi for the course shall be as prescribed by the standing academic board from time to time.

REGULATIONS FOR EXAMINATION:

University Examination:

Theory and practical examinations shall be conducted at the end of first year



and second year respectively in the subjects as per syllabus. If the candidate fails, he/she will be allowed to appear in supplementary examinations (September or March) either in failed subjects or along with other subjects in subsequent examinations.

- (a) Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
- (b) The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 (four) years.
- (c) Candidate who fails in any subject shall be permitted to continue the studies into the second year. However the candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the second year examination till such time that he or she passes all subjects of the first year M.Sc Nursing Examination

Cut off dates for Admission to the Examinations:

- (a) The candidates admitted up to 30th June of the academic year will be registered to take up their first year M.Sc Nursing examinations on 1st June of the ensuing year.
- (b) The candidates admitted up to 30th September of the academic year will be registered to take up their 1st year M.Sc Nursing examinations, after fulfillment of the regulations on 1st December of the ensuing year.

Scheme of Examination:

1. Minimum pass marks shall be 50 % in each of the Theory and practical papers separately.
2. A candidate must have minimum of 90% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.
3. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree
4. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
5. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (Theory and practical).

6. Maximum no. of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
7. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 (four) years

Eligibility for appearing for the examination:

The candidate should possess 90 % of the attendance for theory and practicals for appearing for the examination.

Internal Assessment:

- a) There shall be an internal assessment in all the subjects, and marks for each subject will be according to the weightage given to each subject. The Internal Assessment Mark shall be an aggregate of 3 sessional examinations in theory/practical.
- b) The college examinations along with marks of all evaluation will form the final grade for the Internal Assessment for the subjects. These marks shall be submitted to the University two weeks before commencement to the University Examinations.
- c) Any candidate who fails in the Internal Assessment shall be given an opportunity to improve the Internal Assessment. A candidate shall secure 50% marks in theory/practical examinations separately in each subject/practical to be eligible to appear for the University examinations

Classification of results:

- 50% pass in each of the theory and practical separately.
- 50-59% Second division
- 60-74% first division
- 75% and above is distinction
- For declaring the rank aggregate of 2 years marks to be considered

Note :-

- (a) Students have to maintain log book for each activity during the course of study



- (b) The college examinations along with marks of all evaluation will form the final grade for the Internal Assessment for the subjects. These marks will be submitted to the University before commencement of the University Examinations.
- c) Any candidate who fails in the Internal Assessment should be given an opportunity to improve the Internal Assessment. A candidate shall secure 50% examinations in theory/practical separately in each subject/practical to be eligible to appear for the University examinations.

Marks Qualifying for a Pass:

A candidate shall be declared to have passed the examination in Nursing subject if he/she secures 50% of the marks in the University written examinations, 50% of the marks in the University practical examination and 50% of marks in the aggregate of the Internal Assessment and University written, practical and oral examinations together.

Award of Class:

The candidate who obtains

- (a) 75% (Seventy five percent) in aggregate is considered to have passed in First Class with distinction.
- (b) 60% (Sixty per cent) in aggregate is considered to have passed in First Class.
- (c) 50% (Fifty per cent) is considered to have passed.
- (d) Below 50% (fifty per cent) is considered to have failed.

DISSERTATION

Tentative Schedule for dissertation

1. Submission of the research Proposal End of 9th month of 1st year
2. Submission of dissertation –Final End of 9th month of IInd' Year

Note: - Administrative approval and ethical clearance should be obtained

Submission of Dissertation:

The candidate shall submit a dissertation in the field of speciality, two months

before the final examination for valuing the certification. During the programme of study the candidate is required to write a dissertation in his/her speciality.

Evaluation of Dissertation:

The dissertation shall be valued by

- a) Professor or Reader in Clinical speciality
- b) An external examiner with Nursing Research experience who will be common to all.

The number of pages of dissertation should not exceed 100 pages.

Resubmission of Thesis:

Resubmission of thesis with corrections can be submitted within 6 months from the date of return from the University. Resubmission of thesis with total re-doing can be done within 2 years.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD OF DEGREE

The candidate will be awarded the Degree of Master of Science in Nursing when a candidate has put in the prescribed programme of study for two years and successfully completed all programme requirements including the submission of dissertation.

VACATION

There shall be no vacation for the PG course.

UNIFORM AND BOOKS:

The candidates are expected to have 2-3 sets of prescribed uniform and purchase the textbooks, notebooks and record books as prescribed by the college.

FEES AND PAYMENT:

At the time of admission, prescribed fees should be paid. Tuition fees and other fees of each year should be paid at the beginning of the year. No student will be allowed to attend classes unless she complies with all the admission requirements and pays all the fees for the year. The fees are subject to change.

HOSTEL:

Students can also reside in the hostel. Students residing in the hostel are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel and are accountable to the Warden / House Keeper.



GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Students who voluntarily withdraw from the college shall be required to pay the full fees for the entire course.
2. The college does not take any responsibility for the loss of personal property. Students who keep valuable goods such as Jewellery do so at their own risk.
3. Students are required to wear the full uniform during their clinical duty. When in uniform no form of jewellery is permitted to be worn except small ear studs without drops for female students only. When in uniform hair must be put up.
4. No stipend will be given throughout the course. Fees once remitted will not be refunded.
5. If the student falls sick and wants to avail sick leave during working hours, student has to produce medical certificate from Medical Officer, MMM Hospital or from any registered medical Practitioner.
6. Disciplinary actions will be taken on the students who are not complying by the rules and regulations of the college.
7. **Warning:** Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, candidates found guilty will be expelled from the Institution.
